## Institution Summary

Morehouse College is a fully accredited, private, liberal arts, Historically Black College for men that assumes special responsibility for producing the nation's next generation of servant-leaders. Founded in 1867, Morehouse's mission is to develop men with disciplined minds who will lead lives of leadership and service. Morehouse realizes this mission by emphasizing the intellectual and character development; as a result, its alumni include leaders in the arts, sports, education, government, medicine, and STEM. The College is a member of the Atlanta University Center Consortium and enrolls 2100 students in 30 majors across 7 academic divisions. The student-faculty ratio of 12:1 allows students to work closely with faculty. Over 70% of the faculty hold terminal degrees in their fields and most (80%) are engaged in research, scholarship, or creative production. In a recent Survey of Earned Doctorates, Morehouse was ranked as the #1 baccalaureate-origin institution for African American males who earned doctorates in the Life Sciences, Physical Sciences and Social Sciences.
